Here are some of the numbers that describe what went on:

- 10 Bourne Quilters shows preceded this one, which made this the 11th show
- 42 were the number of members who registered quilts to display at the show
- 65 people tried to guess how many cotton reels were in the bowl – there were 552
- 82 people had a go at the lucky dip
- 146 people tried their luck at the tombola and 22 people went home with a beautiful bag
- 171 quilts were on show and this doesn't include the selfies, afternoon tea display or the work of the Challenge Group
- 246 people enjoyed a cuppa and cake – just think about all that baking
- 506 people came to the show which was 150 more than in 2022
