Chat from the Chair

Meeting Report 1st April

We had a good turn out for this meeting, despite it being a Bank Holiday. We started with a demonstration of the revamped Bourne Quilters Website from Frances, who has done an amazing job pulling everything together. As well as showing the general layout and where you can find past newsletters and the BQ programme, Frances talked about the "Making for Others" section where you can find information on how to make quilts for Special Care Baby Cots and Incubator quilts, as well as Borrow Bags (see below). She also emphasised the Show page which will continue to develop as we get nearer the show. You can



already see details of the "End Wall Project" and the "Chairperson's Challenge", as well as instructions for how to create a sleeve for your quilts.

Francis also gave some feedback from the Borrow Bag workshop held on April 6th in Cosham, where she delivered 11 bags that had been made by BQ members (left). In Emsworth, the bags are being used in a number of places, including the PO10 gift shop, the Bookshop (right), the Butchers and the Greengrocers.



Karen gave us feedback from the scrappy workshop we had in March and showed us how she had used scrappy square to make a book cover.



Caron showed an example of a scrappy roll she was building.

The rest of the evening was a mixture of people doing their own sewing - and sharing what they were doing - and learning from others about things like putting a sleeve on a quilt, making a BQ Sash etc. It was a lovely opportunity to learn from each other and make new friends.

Fabric Flowers Workshop – 20th April



A small group of us (6) joined Alyson Griffiths who showed us how to make large fabric flowers similar to those that were made at the 'Sewing for the show' workshop. It was a brilliant day, the sun shone outside as we set about making the flowers in a range of designs. We experimented with some techniques which was fun and at the end of the day we had all completed a flower.

It was quite addictive, and I can see a spring bunch budding in my sewing room. The chatter was great and the ideas for the different uses (not just a bunch of flowers) came out as part of the creative process.
