

Bourne Quilters Quilt Show

Saturday 25th and Sunday 26th July 2026

The Bourne Quilters Quilt Show takes place every 2 years which means that 2026 is our next show year. For those of you new to Bourne Quilters, and in case anyone needs a nudge to their memory, we take over the whole of the Emsworth Community Centre for the show weekend. The January 2026 newsletter will have a full article about the show but here are the dates for your diary.

For those of you new to Bourne Quilters one of the things we do for the show is a Chair's Challenge. I have the honour of setting it this year. The challenge is to make a record out of fabric and decorate it with something that represents an 33 rpm album, 45 single, or if you wish a 78! The only rule is that the record should be the size of a 33, 45, or 78. The decoration can be 2D or 3D applique, embroidery, machine embroidery – whatever you fancy. Next month we will give some guidance on how to make the record part. There was some hilarity at a committee meeting recently when I declared the first record I bought was Chuck Berry and 'My ding a ling' – the 11 year old Karen had no idea what it was about – not sure I will be making it as my record!

2 day non-residential retreat

Quilting with your walking foot (and getting out of the ditch)

25th – 26th April. Cost £70. Sarah Ashford.



This 2 day workshop is not until April but as it's 2 days we wanted to give our members time to plan. This is a first for Bourne Quilters – a full weekend non residential retreat. There are not many workshops that concentrate on the techniques of using your walking foot, threads and quilting (out of the ditch). So we are very excited to have this opportunity for Sarah to come and teach.

Day 1 is an introduction to using your walking foot, covering the basics, threads, getting set up and then practising on a number of pieces.
Day 2 involves more practice and developing the patterns you can make with your walking foot.

There will be another chance to get your machines PAT tested on Tuesday 16th December at Westbourne and again at the bag making workshop on 31st January.

Young Quilters


